### Overview

Finally, under her last two supervisors she assisted in High Court employment disputes regarding restrictive covenants, misuse of confidential information and breach of fiduciary duties. Throughout pupillage, Maryam assisted with a wide range of matters, including researching for cases in the Supreme Court and the Employment Appeal Tribunal as well as assisting with investigations, disciplinary and regulatory work.

Before pupillage, Maryam was a Lincoln's Inn Sir Thomas More Scholar and Aziz Foundation Scholar. Her experience specialised in Employment and Equalities Law.
